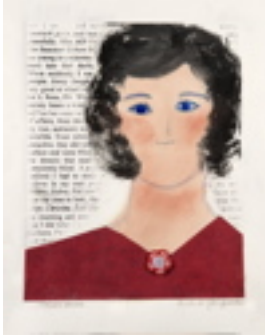

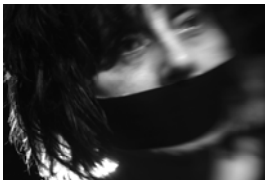

The Invisible/Invincible Women Project is a way to explore how women in our society become invisible and lose their voice. Through visual and audio arts and expression, two local artists collaborate to explore this theme:



Portraits of Women of a Certain Age is an interactive installation of portraits hung on raffia with clothespins. Linda Dubin Garfield created this series of mixed media portraits using other women's and her own experiences about being invisible in our society.

Men and women of all ages are invited to create their own portraits using mixed media supplied by the artist. These portraits may be included in this on-going installation. Portraits created at a previous installation will also be exhibited.



“screams” is an interactive audio piece created by Pink Hanger Presents/Susan DiPronio in which the viewer is able to participate by listening to the recorded personal stories of women. Going beyond the typical facade of everyday encounters, the viewer/listener will have an opportunity to hear women tell their real stories.

Participants will also have an opportunity to tape their own stories and be part of this on-going installation.

Proceeds from this exhibit will benefit the Darfur Alert Coalition.
